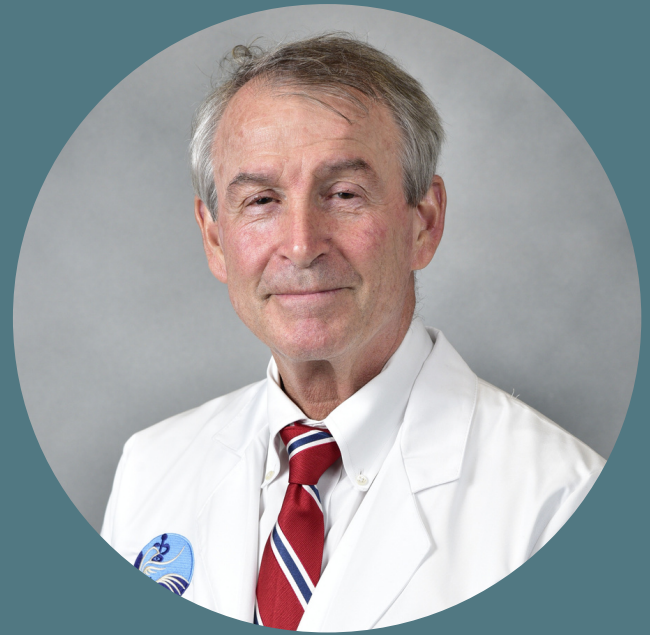


PHYSICIAN LEADERSHIP IS KEY

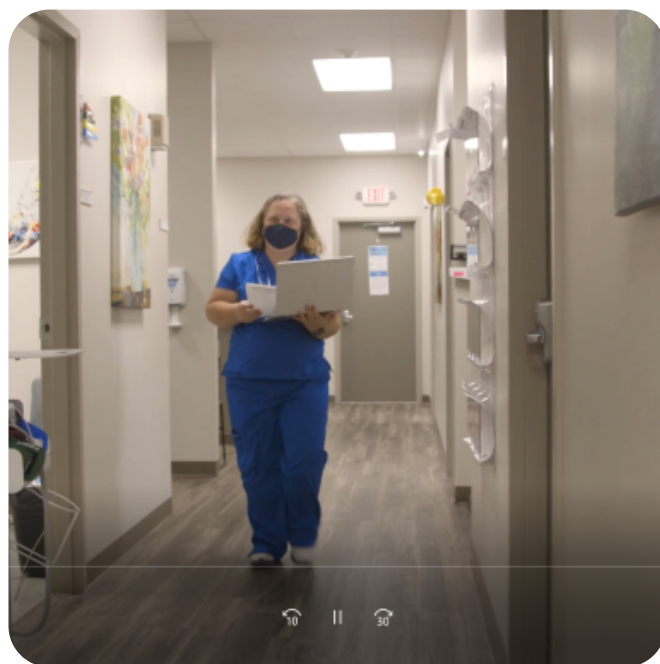
COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTERS:

Community Health Centers are clinical practices of primary care providers available to provide medical care to all individuals, no matter a person's socioeconomic status. A Community Health Center is located in an area where there is a HPSA and MUA designation. HPSA (Health Professional Shortage Area) stands for the physician to population ratio. MUA (Medically Underserved Area) includes such things as the HPSA, infant mortality rate, percent of poverty for the area, and percent of elderly population. At AAPHC, we are proud to make our services available, affordable, acceptable, and accessible to all. We believe that all of our local residents deserve access to quality health care.

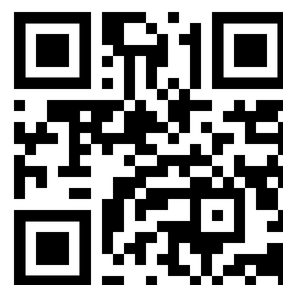

AAPHC providers and staff believe that compassionate care doesn't stop at the office. You'll often find our AAPHC Family volunteering in the community!



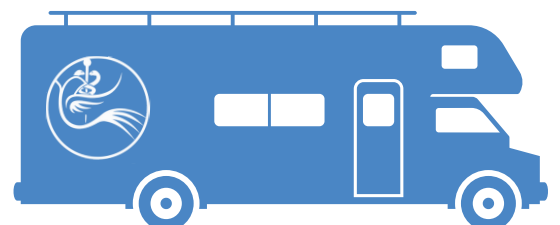
OUR MOBILE ACCESS CARE UNITS ARE ON THE ROADWAYS
